Dear Chapter Members and Students:

The Tahoma Chapter of the National Association of Teachers of Singing (NATS) is pleased to announce its thirteenth annual Scholarship Award and Auditions. This year we will award one \$1,000 scholarship and one \$500 scholarship to high school seniors graduating in June 2019.

To be eligible to participate in the scholarship audition on Sun. Feb. 3, 2019, students must:

- I. Be currently studying with a Tahoma Chapter member for at least six months
- II. Be a senior in high school or equivalent home school and be graduating June 2019
- III. By January 20, 2019, pay the \$20 accompanist fee and complete an online application found on the Tahoma NATS website ([www.tahomanats.org](http://www.tahomanats.org)) which includes:
  - A one-page essay explaining how he/she believes this scholarship will benefit his/her future plans, and how he/she has been inspired by music
  - A program of three pieces, per the repertoire requirements as described in the Scholarship Guidelines. (*Please note the revised guidelines this year.*)

**The scholarship winner will be required to perform at the Tahoma Chapter's Spring Fling Recital on April 28, 1:00 p.m. The winner will bring her or her own accompanist to this event.**

If any of the application requirements are not fulfilled, the applicant will be disqualified from further participation.
