Application Deadline:	Sunday, February 7, 2021, 11:59PM PT
Scholarship Audition:	Sunday, Feb. 21, 2021, 3:00 PM PT
Spring Fling Recital:	Sunday, March 28, 2021, TBD

In addition to scholarship awards, all applicants will receive written comments from our three judges:

<u>Linda McAlister</u>, Executive Director of Schmidt Vocal Arts <u>Barry Johnson</u>, Assistant Professor of Music, Pacific Lutheran University <u>Leischen Moore</u>, Voice Teacher and Founder of Rare Bird Studios

To be eligible, the student applicant must:

- I. Be currently studying with a Tahoma NATS Chapter member for at least six months
- II. Be a senior in high school (or homeschool equivalent), and graduating in June 2021
- III. Submit a completed <u>online application</u>, which includes the following:
  - a) Two contrasting selections
  - b) An essay (minimum of 500 words)
- IV. Attend the Scholarship Audition virtually on Sunday, Feb. 21, 2021, 3:00 PM
- V. Submit a performance video for the Spring Fling Student Recital, if chosen as a winner

All application requirements must be completed to be considered. Late applications will not be accepted.
